We remind you it must be the cheapest possible flight. (low cost companies).

Rules of the center of accommodation :

6. Conferences:

Tuesday 22 – Conference: “We are not a lost generation”

Youth and crisis throughout Europe. Causes of the crisis, is it just an economic crisis? We face a double crisis: economic (the one shown) and values (the first cause). Back to the values that built Europe, solidarity, social justice, the common good. This is, replace human beings at the center of economic and political activity.

Reflection: As the young generation, how do we perceive the crisis? And what can we do in order to overcome it?

Thursday 24 – Conference: “How does the crisis affect democracy?”

The crisis has produced the discrediting of political parties and the rise of new social movements, the citizen empowerment. But it's not enough, in order to make a real social change we have to change the hearts of people first, reminding them of the most important values, solidarity, cooperation, compassion ... and, to guide the change, we need service-minded leaders. Models of deep humanity for a disoriented society that show that "You can live like this ... I want to live like that!"

Reflection: Are we, today's youth, too lazy to fulfill our social responsibilities? Changing the heart of our society depends on every one of us. How I can change my reality?

Saturday 26 – Conference: "Our vocation as Europeans: the defense and promotion of human rights and freedom."

Usually, when we think about the European Union, we think of the economy, our common currency: the Euro. But the European project is much larger: the defense and promotion of human rights. Things as important as human rights, the dignity and the idea of freedom, are rooted in European ideals. We, as Europeans, have a special duty to promote and defend human rights in Europe and worldwide.
